Oulton Class

This week Year 1 and 2 have been learning about subtraction in maths and Reception have been learning about number bonds to 20. In PE we played rounders on the field and in Outdoor learning we learnt about plants and how they grow.

Ranworth Class

This week in Ranworth the children have been getting their creative minds going! They have been making a lovely watercolour painting focusing on the project theme they decided of: Nature and the Wild. The outdoor learning lesson with Mr Mummery used natural materials and some paints in there to create a lovely welcoming poster to our class. The children are becoming more and more excited to show you all of their arts and crafts that are coming together and cannot wait for the unveiling of their art gallery. Hickling Class

This week in Hickling, the children have been finding out more about the Silk Road and why it was important. They have imagined that they are a character travelling on the Silk Road and thought about feelings and the conditions that they may have faced 1800 years ago. There has been some fantastic writing. In maths, the focus has been on shape and the class have learnt about different shapes, interior angles of shapes, regular/irregular polygons and drawing shapes accurately. For once, we had pleasant weather for PE this week and the class are getting more confident at playing the game fairly and applying the rules and skills that they have learnt. Outdoor learning was fun; the children foraged for sticks to build a fire, had the opportunity to chop vegetables and heat a vegetable curry on over the fire.

Name ALL uniform; Please remember to write your child's name in **all** their school uniform and PE kit, this helps staff to reunite lost clothing with your child.

Office Hours; The office is open 8:30am – 3:30pm please leave a message on the answer phone outside of these hours.

Registers; The school gate opens at 8:40am and closes at 8:45am. Registers in class are taken at 8;45am. If you arrive after 8:45am you will need to buzz the office and your child will be marked as late with the number of minutes recorded. The registers close at 8:55am arrival at 8:55am or after will be recorded as an unauthorised absence and will affect your child's attendance.

Holidays; Holiday taken during term time will not be authorised and may results in a Fixed Penalty Notice of £60 being issued per child, per parent. So, for a family of four that could mean a fine of £240.00. From September 2024 this will increase to £80 per child.

Wellies and Waterproofs; If possible please can all the children have wellies and waterproofs in school for outdoor learning. Their wellies and waterproofs can stay in school. Please can you name your child's wellies and waterproofs. Oulton Class Wednesday afternoon. Ranworth Class Tuesday afternoon. Hickling class Thursday afternoon.

Chewing gum and cough sweets; Chewing gum is NOT allowed in school. If your child needs cough/throat lozenge in school then these must be brought to the office in the morning so they are supervised when eating them and not shared with other children.
